For the Senate Dems: a new categorical aid under DPI, "Aid for high poverty districts." This will be an annual appropriation, \$9,000,000 GPR in 2007-08 and \$12,000,000 GPR in 2008-09. School districts are eligible if at least 50% of their enrollments were eligible for free or reduced-price lunch under the National School Lunch Program, based on the October 2006 count. Also, they want revenue limits to apply to this aid, in order to force down property tax levies. Aid will be paid per pupil, based on a district's total enrollment (not just free/reduced enrollment). So, essentially the appropriation is divided by the total enrollment of all eligible districts, then this per pupil amount is multiplied by each district's total enrollment. Again, the October 2006 count should be used for aid distribution purposes in both 2007-08 and 2008-09. I think that's it. Let me know if you have questions-- Thanks

Federal Regulation 7 CFR 210.5 (d) (1) states:

"Each State Agency shall submit a final Report of School Program Operations (FNS-10) to FNS for each month. The final report shall be limited to claims submitted in accordance with 210.8. For the month of October, the final report shall include the total number of children approved for free lunches, the total number of children approved for reduced price lunches, and the total number of children enrolled in participating public schools, private schools, and residential child care institutions, respectively, as of the last day of operation in October....."

The October Enrollment and Participation Report collects data from the October claim which requests the highest number of students approved for free and reduced price meals. Enrollment is based on the number of students who had access to the school lunch program in October.

If you want language that directs use of the Enrollment and Participation Report for distribution of funds, perhaps this would do it: "The department shall make payments to eligible schools from the appropriation under s. xxx.xx based on the students eligible for free and reduced priced meals and enrollment data submitted to the department on the October claim for the National School Lunch Program. Eligible schools are defined as those equaling or exceeding 50% of enrollment eligible for free and reduced price meals."

The question to consider is when do you want the payments to be made. If the payments are to be made early in the school year, language could be added to use the previous year's October data. Of course, if the school did not participate in the previous year, the law would have to address how or if payments should be made.

Hope this helps.
