Hi again—the Senate wants to modify the school library provision from JFC (#17, page 554 of our summary). The change is below.

Modify the bill to require that, if school library aid is used to purchase computers and software, then they must be housed in the school library. Delete the requirement that such purchases be approved by the school district's library media coordinator. Instead, specify that the district would be required to consult with the library media coordinator on such purchases.

Also, Tracy, DPI is working on finding a statutory citation for the October count. I found some federal regs, and I know it's title 42, chapter 13 of USC, but that's as far as I got before being buried under other stuff. I'll let you know when I hear something from DPI. Meanwhile if you're interested, I think the federal regs are:
7 CFR part 210, part 215, and part 220
