If you have any can you send over your notes on the ATV private landowner incentive program to the LRB so that Roger can work on getting it drafted as a caucus amendment?

Brett, Aaron, are you guys the right ones to deal with a program that would:

In '07-08 take \$100,000 from the ATV account  
Thereafter use all of the money from the non-resident ATV registration fee towards a new private landowner program.

The new program would allow a landowner to submit to the DNR on a claim basis for reimbursement of public-use ATV trails on their property. Up to \$100/mile. It would be prorated if there were more claims submitted than money available.

The draft would also include an increase in the non-resident vehicle registration starting in '08-09 up to \$35.

I think we were going to have the county forester/recreation officer verify the mileage? Let me know when you (or whomever you send it to) gets to this point.


