

Hi Robin/Mary- For draft 0545, I had another concern. The draft has the moneys collected under the voluntary contribution going to appropriation 20.370(6)(as) (the new appropriation created in draft 0223/3 for grants to control invasive species), except, that approp is a biennial "amounts in the schedule" approp. I had thought that we would create another new appropriation, a continuing, all moneys received appropriation for the voluntary contributions, and then we'd have the grants for the control of aquatics come from either of the two appropriations. Does that make sense? If not, give me a call and we'll work on it.

Robin- With regard to your drafter's notes on draft 0545/1, I think that the voluntary contribution should only be listed on the fishing licenses under 29.563(3) not the stamps and tags (so not all of the *approvals*). In order to purchase a stamp or tag you already have to have purchased a license, so we wouldn't want to ask people if they wanted to make a voluntary contribution to aquatic invasive grants twice. As for your second question, the exemption for the lac du flambeau issuance is fine. I think that's it. Otherwise the draft looks good. Thanks,
