Hello:

I'm told that I should give you what I have so far in drafting requests from the ARC.

Pam:

1. Delete the provision to transfer FSET from DWD to DHFS, which also puts the W-2 services allocation at \$46,584,100 annually. [1313/4 in Gov's bill and 79/1 in JFC]
2. Delete Real work real pay project, which puts the benefits allocation at \$44,026,500 in 2007-08 and \$43,309,200 in 2008-09 [486/1 in Gov's bill and 148/1 in JFC]
3. Change initial child care eligibility to 145% of the federal poverty level and change the higher threshold once eligible to 160% of the FPL [1538/2 in Gov's bill and 149/2 in JFC].
4. Eliminate the attendance-based reimbursement cost savings measure—49.155(6m) [149/2 in JFC]—change the direct child care subsidies allocation to \$302,051,800 in 2007-08 and \$306,552,000 in 2008-09.
5. Under 49.155(1g)(a), eliminate any references to minimum amounts that must be spent for child care scholarships, referral services, etc. Quality care for quality kids allocation would be \$5,671,100 annually. [149/2 in JFC]
6. Change the child care licensing allocation to \$4,440,500 annually and eliminate the "at least." [149/2 in JFC]
7. Change the child care state administration allocation to \$1,524,900 annually and change 49.155(1g)(b) to \$1,524,900 annually. [149/2 in JFC]
8. Change the state administration allocation to \$16,422,900 annually. [147/3 in JFC]
9. Change the earned income tax credit allocation to \$59,764,400 in 2007-08 and \$59,764,500 in 2008-09. [147/3 in JFC]
10. Change the Child Welfare Safety Services to \$5,707,200 annually. [147/3 in JFC]
11. Change the Milwaukee and statewide child welfare administration allocation to \$1,317,700 annually. [147/3 in JFC]
12. Make the statutory changes to allow DWD to place W-2 participants into a "job ready" category without being employed and without receiving cash benefits.

Debora:

1. Delete the provision to change 20.445(5)(a) to a continuing appropriation. [489/1 in Gov's bill]



Went through the draft. We don't think 1409h should be included. Since they're not getting cash benefits, we don't think the time limits should be triggered. Other than that, I went through the statutes to see if case management services should be added in other places, went through some potential areas with Rob, and we concluded that it doesn't need to be added anywhere else.

I'm still waiting to hear from my Assembly work group. There could be major changes to the child care subsidy program (they haven't decided yet), so I'm waiting to send you appropriation changes, along with any other directions®
