

Okay they took a final vote on their K-12 package, with a few last minute floor amendments:

1. Delete "middle school" from the current law language on gifted and talented grants.
2. Final pupil transportation appropriation is \$34,315,000, and the final pupil transportation rates are:
 - a. Unusual hazards: \$17
 - b. 2 to 5: \$41
 - c. 5 to 8: \$71
 - d. 8 to 12: \$151
 - e. Over 12: \$350
3. School safety grants: specify that distribution will be on a cost reimbursement basis among all districts submitting eligible claims; specify that eligible claims means costs allowable under federal Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act; specify that if in any year the appropriation is insufficient to cover all eligible claims, aid will be prorated.
