1. COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL AID -- FUNDING LEVEL

	Chg. to JFC
GPR	-\$58,000,000

Delete the provision recommended by the Governor and approved by the Joint Committee on Finance that would increase payments under the county and municipal aid program by \$15 million annually, beginning in 2008 (2008-09), and instead, modify the county and municipal aid program as follows.

Funding Level in 2008. Reduce payments under the county and municipal aid program by \$43 million in 2008 (2008-09). Decrease payments to each county and municipality by a uniform percentage, estimated at 5%, to achieve the statewide reduction. Estimate the 2008 distribution at \$816,703,200, which includes payments totaling \$149,356,200 for counties and \$667,347,000 for municipalities. Direct the Department of Revenue to calculate the amount of the reduction in 2008 for each county and municipality.

Distribution and Funding Level in 2009 and Thereafter. Provide that each county receive the same amount of county and municipal aid in 2009 and thereafter as the amount received in 2008. Reduce each municipality's payment from the county and municipal aid account appropriation in 2009 by an amount equal to the municipality's payment from that appropriation in 2008 divided by 20. Reduce each municipality's payment in each of the 19 succeeding years by the amount of the municipality's reduction in 2009. Establish a separate, sum sufficient appropriation to fund additional aid payments to municipalities beginning in 2009. Set the funding level for the appropriation in 2009-10 as the sum of: (a) the amount resulting from multiplying the statewide distribution of aid payments to municipalities under the county and municipal aid program in 2008-09 by the percentage change in the total amount of individual and corporate income tax and general sales and use tax collections deposited in the general fund, as reported in the state annual fiscal report (budgetary basis), between 2006-07 and 2007-08; and (b) the sum of the reductions in municipal payments from the county and municipal aid account appropriation in that year. Increase the funding level for the appropriation in subsequent years by an amount equal to the sum of: (a) the amount resulting from adding the statewide distribution of aid payments under the newly-created appropriation in the prior year to the distribution to municipalities under the county and municipal aid program in the prior year, and multiplying the result by the percentage change in the total amount of individual and corporate income tax and general sales and use tax collections deposited in the general fund, as reported in the state annual fiscal report (budgetary basis), between the fiscal year ending in the year two years prior to the year of the distribution and the fiscal year ending in the year prior to the year of the distribution; and (b) the sum of the reductions in municipal payments from the county and municipal aid account appropriation in that year.

Distribute the additional aid in the new appropriation in proportion to each municipality's initial aid entitlement, based on the following calculations. Set each municipality's initial aid entitlement equal to the greater of \$25 multiplied by the municipality's population or an amount determined under an equalizing formula that supports a calculated amount of spending for each municipality, based on three components. Establish the first expenditure component as an amount equal to \$150 multiplied by the population of the municipality, up to 2,000. Extend the second expenditure component to municipalities with populations over 2,000 and establish the component as that portion of the municipality's population in excess of 2,000 multiplied by an additional per capita amount. Extend the third expenditure component to municipalities that provide around-the-clock police protection and establish the component as \$200 multiplied by the municipality's population. Set the additional per capita amount for the second expenditure component as the amount that results in the distribution of the entire amount of aid for municipalities under the county and municipal aid program and the new appropriation combined. Calculate each municipality's initial aid entitlement by multiplying the sum of the three expenditure amounts by a sharing factor, which would be calculated by comparing the municipality's per capita tax base to the per capita tax base for the entire state. Provide that municipalities with per capita tax base amounts exceeding the statewide average would not receive aid under this distribution. Increase the \$25 per person minimum guarantee by the percentage used to calculate the increase in municipal aid in the combined appropriations, as described above, beginning with aid payments in 2010.



Please consider two changes to LRBb0821/2.

First, the proposal should create 3 categories of local governments:

1. Counties who get cut 5%;
2. 1,846 municipalities that get the same amount in 2008 as in 2007; and
3. 4 municipalities that get cut 12.5%.

I think we need three paragraphs, but the draft does not deal with group #2.

I suggest converting paragraph (b) [lines 7 to 12, on page 2] to paragraph (c).

To deal with group #2, paragraph (b) could be created to read:

Except as provided in s. 79.02(3)(e) and paragraph (c), in 2008 each municipality shall receive a payment under this section and s. 79.035 that is equal to the amount it received in 2007.

8 79.043 (5) Except as provided under s. 79.02 (3) (e), for the distribution
9 beginning in 2005 and subsequent years ending in 2007, each county and
10 municipality shall receive a payment under this section and s. 79.035 that is equal

1 to the amount of the payment determined for the county or municipality under this
2 section and s. 79.035 in 2004.

3 **SECTION 2507d.** 79.043 (6) of the statutes is created to read:

4 79.043 (6) (a) Except as provided in s. 79.02 (3) (e), in 2008 each county shall
5 receive a payment under this section and s. 79.035 that is equal to the amount it
6 received in 2007, minus 5 percent of the amount it received in 2007.

7 (b) Except as provided in s. 79.02 (3) (e) and par. (c), in 2008 each municipality
8 shall receive a payment under this section and s. 79.035 that is equal to the amount
9 it received in 2007.

10 (c) Except as provided in s. 79.02 (3) (e), in 2008 each municipality shall receive
11 a payment under this section and s. 79.035 that is equal to the amount it received
12 in 2007, minus 12.5 percent of the amount it received in 2007, if the municipality's
13 2007 population exceeded 20,000 and if its distribution under this section and s.
14 79.035 in 2007 exceeded an amount equal to the municipality's 2007 population
15 multiplied by \$250.

16 **SECTION 2507e.** 79.043 (7) of the statutes is created to read:

17 79.043 (7) Except as provided under s. 79.02 (3) (e), for the distribution in 2009
18 and subsequent years, each county and municipality shall receive a payment under
19 this section and s. 79.035 that is equal to the amount of the payment determined for
20 the county or municipality under this section and s. 79.035 in 2008.”.

21 **5.** Page 1677, line 8: delete the material beginning with “sections” and ending
22 with “79.035 (1)” on line 9 and substitute “section 20.835 (1) (db), (dc), and (q)”.
