Cellular Phone Provider Participation in the Federal Universal Service Fund

[LFB Paper #670]

Motion:

Move to authorize the Commission to promulgate rules to designate commercial mobile radio service providers, who petition the Commission, as eligible telecommunications carriers for purposes of participation under the federal universal service fund.

Note:

State law allows the Public Service Commission (PSC) to impose USF assessments on commercial mobile radio service providers, although the Commission previously suspended such assessments. Previously, the Committee adopted Motion #98, which would permanently exclude commercial mobile radio service providers from USF assessments. That motion requires the repeal of a current law provision that extends universal service fund provisions to commercial mobile radio service providers if the Public Service Commission promulgates rules that designate commercial mobile radio service providers as eligible to receive universal service funding under both the federal and state universal service fund programs. This motion retains the Commission's authority to designate commercial mobile radio service providers as eligible participants under the federal program. Individual providers would be required to petition the Commission for designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier.
