Delete provision that would have created an Office of Energy Independence as follows: (a) modify the Governor's recommendation by deleting 8.0 SEG positions supported from the public benefits fund and transfer \$609,600 SEG annually from salaries and fringe benefits to supplies and service for use in low-income heating assistance grants; (b) delete 1.0 FED administrative manager position from the Department's federal aid appropriation and transfer \$103,700 FED annually from salaries and fringe benefits to supplies and services for use in low-income heating assistance grants (c) delete the creation of the Office of Energy Independence and the duties of the staff and the goals of the Office. Reestimate the amount of funding available for Low-Income Home Energy Assistance by 103,700 FED annually and \$609,600 SEG annually.

Delete provision that would have created an Office of Energy Independence as follows: (a) modify the Governor's recommendation by deleting 2.0 SEG positions supported from the public benefits fund and transfer \$138,900 SEG annually from salaries and fringe benefits to supplies and service for use in low-income heating assistance grants; (b) delete 6.0 FED administrative manager position from the Department's federal aid appropriation and transfer \$427,700 FED annually from salaries and fringe benefits to supplies and services for use in low-income heating assistance grants; (c) delete 1.0 PR position from services to nonstate government services appropriation and transfer \$71,100 from salary and fringe benefits to supplies and services; and (d) delete the creation of the Office of Energy Independence and the duties of the staff and the goals of the Office. Reestimate the amount of funding available for Low-Income Home Energy Assistance by 427,700 FED and \$138,900 SEG annually.

2 **1.** Page 71, line 15: after "assistance" insert "and the office of energy
3 independence".

4 **2.** Page 74, line 3: after that line insert:

*delete 19-18
→ 19-22*

5 "SECTION 35m. 15.105 (30) of the statutes is created to read:

6 15.105 (30) OFFICE OF ENERGY INDEPENDENCE. There is created an office of
7 energy independence in the department of administration. The office shall be
8 headed by an executive director and shall have staff sufficient to carry out the duties
9 under s. 16.956."

10 **3.** Page 99, line 5: after that line insert:

11 "SECTION 117m. 16.956 of the statutes is created to read:

delete 48-24 → 50-2

1 **16.956 Office of energy independence. (1)** In this section:

2 (a) “Biodevelopment” means research and development relating to the use of
3 renewable resources for electricity, energy, and heating and transportation fuels.

4 (b) “Bioindustry” means the manufacture, production, and trade of renewable
5 resources used for electricity, energy, and heating and transportation fuels.

6 (c) “Office” means the office of energy independence.

7 **(2)** The office shall work on initiatives that have the following goals:

8 (a) Advancing Wisconsin’s vision for energy independence by generating at
9 least 25 percent of power, and at least 25 percent of transportation fuels, used in this
10 state from renewable resources by 2025.

11 (b) Capturing in-state at least 10 percent of the national emerging bioindustry
12 and renewable energy markets by 2030.

13 (c) Ensuring that Wisconsin is a national leader in groundbreaking research
14 that will make alternative energies more affordable and create well-paying jobs in
15 this state.

16 **(3)** The office shall do all of the following:

17 (a) Ensure and facilitate the implementation of the initiatives specified in sub.
18 (2) and identify barriers to the implementation of such initiatives.

19 (b) Serve as a single point of contact to assist businesses, local units of
20 government, and nongovernmental organizations that are pursuing
21 biodevelopment, energy efficiency, and energy independence.

22 (c) Develop energy independence policy options for consideration by the
23 governor and state agencies.

24 (d) Identify federal funding opportunities and facilitate applications for federal
25 funding by private, and state and local governmental, entities.
