SECTION 2m. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) Any individual who was in possession, on September 1, 2007, of special plates described in section 341.14 (6r) (g) 2. of the statutes, as created by this act, who suffered an injury in the course of his or her job duties as a fire fighter, rescue squad member, or emergency medical technician that prevents the individual from subsequently performing such job duties, and who was required to surrender these special plates between September 1, 2007 and the effective date of this subsection or whose special plates expired during this time period may apply to the department of transportation for reissuance of these special plates. Upon application, the department of transportation shall reissue these special plates at no additional fee."
