<b>Description</b> The amount of the exemption from income tax withholding requirements for employees of a county fair association					

### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current Wisconsin law, county fair associations are exempt from withholding income tax from an employee who receives less than \$100 annually in wages or salary from the association. This bill would increase this ceiling from \$100 to \$500.

This bill would not have a significant impact on individual income tax revenue or Department of Revenue costs. The bill would delay the receipt of income tax revenue from wages or salaries paid to county fair association employees who earn between \$100 and \$500 to the time when they file their income tax returns. However, this is not expected to have a significant effect.
