## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Summary: This bill would allow a nonresident member of the Armed Forces who was a resident of Wisconsin at the time they entered the military to purchase hunting and fishing approvals at resident fees. In addition to fishing approvals, the hunting approvals include Small Game, Deer, Archery, Spring and Fall Turkey, Class A Bear, Class B Bear, Trapping, Antlerless Deer Tags and After Drawing Turkey Permits. Approvals under this bill also include the Conservation Patron and Sports licenses. This bill also treats a former resident who is on furlough or leave in this state as a current resident on furlough or leave for purposes of being able to hunt deer of either sex during the open season for hunting deer with firearms.

Fiscal Effect: The Department has no information on the number of armed forces personnel affected by this bill who seek hunting and fishing approvals in any given year. Therefore, the Department cannot reliably estimate the bill's fiscal effect on the Fish and Wildlife Account of the Conservation Fund. If the same number of nonresident armed forces members who were residents when they entered the military and former residents on furlough or leave in this state sought hunting and fishing approvals after enactment of this bill as in prior years, revenues would decline. Alternatively, offering hunting and fishing approvals at resident rates may encourage armed forces personnel affected by this bill and who otherwise would not have, to seek the hunting and fishing approvals, consequently reducing the amount of revenue lost -- or possibly increasing revenue.
