<b>Description</b> Restrictions on the operation of motor vehicles by persons holding instruction permits or probationary licenses and providing a penalty		

**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill adds a restriction on persons who hold an instructional permit or probationary license for the operation of a motor vehicle. The permittee would be subject to a forfeiture if he or she uses a wireless telecommunications device while operating a motor vehicle or a Type 1 motorcycle. The forfeiture would be \$50 for the first offense and range from \$50 to \$100 for each subsequent offense.

Additional court proceedings could be generated under the terms of this bill, but it is impossible to predict how frequently that may happen. It is expected that existing court staff would absorb any additional proceedings.

Forfeitures collected may increase because of these new provisions. Under the Wisconsin Constitution, revenue from forfeitures collected by the circuit courts are deposited in the common school fund. Forfeitures collected by municipal courts are retained by the municipality. It is not possible to estimate the potential revenue these forfeitures could generate.
