## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

- -Under this proposal DOT would be prohibited from implementing any provisions of the federal REAL ID Act, unless implementation is 100% funded from the federal government
- -The \$10 Federal Security Verification Mandate Fee for all driver license and identification cards created in Wisconsin Act 20 would remain in place
- -The funding provided for REAL ID implementation in Wisconsin Act 20 (as a result of the Federal Security Verification Mandate Fee) would remain in the SEG fund
- -If DOT were prohibited from implementing REAL ID all of its related provisions in Wisconsin Act 20 will need to be reconciled with this bill

The Act does not impose any new costs on DOT, nor does it affect revenues. However, it does prohibit expenditures that DOT was provided funding for in Wisconsin Act 20. The funding provided in Act 20 (\$6.9 million in FY 08 and \$13.8 million in FY 09) will remain in the SEG fund.
