Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

If enacted, the bill would require the Office of Justice Assistance to collect data relating to the number and nature of the human trafficking violations and to publish statistics relating to those violations. Specifically, the data would need to include the number of investigations, arrests, prosecutions and convictions of persons, and the demographics of victims (nationality, age, method of recruitment, and country, state or city of origin).

The Department of Administration, Office of Justice Assistance, Statistical Analysis Center would be responsible for the collection of the data and the publishing of the statistics. The Center is unable to assume additional responsibilities without additional staff. Also, since this bill would be creating additional state requirements, federal funding from the federal Department of Justice could not be used to fund these tasks. Portions of three employees totaling .90 GPR FTE (Program and Policy Analyst Advanced - 15%, Program and Policy Analyst Senior - 50%, and a Contract Program - 25%) would be assigned to accomplish these job duties. The cost of these positions, including supplies and services, would total \$80,800.

It is estimated that the publishing costs would be \$750 for each 1,000 copies of the report.

It is not possible to determine the local fiscal estimate as data collection is different in each municipality. The time required for collection and submittal of the data in a large municipality or county would likely be higher and at a higher rate of pay for the individual assigned than it would be in a small municipality or in an area where there are few incidents that would need to be reported.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

For the state's long-range fiscal estimate, it would be a minimum annual cost of \$81,550; subject to pay increases and rate of inflation.

The local long-range fiscal estimate is indeterminate.
