Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill requires that every school board's instructional program in state, national and world history include information on the history of organized labor in America and the collective bargaining process.

School districts may incur costs to change their history curriculum to include information on organized labor and the collective bargaining process. The department does not have data from which potential local costs could be calculated, but it is assumed that these costs would be minimal and could be absorbed by the school districts.

It should be noted that some districts may already teach labor history to meet performance standards set in the Model Academic Standards.
