Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Bill Summary:

This bill eliminates municipal licensing of neighborhood electric vehicles and instead requires that these vehicles be registered with the Department of Transportation (DOT). The bill also exempts neighborhood electric vehicles from the \$9 environmental impact fee and the \$7.50 supplemental title fee. Additionally, the bill specifically exempts neighborhood electric vehicles from emissions inspections.

State Fiscal Estimate:

The DNR does not have access to information with which to reliably estimate the number of neighborhood electric vehicles, and therefore lists the fiscal effect as "indeterminate". The bill exempts neighborhood electric vehicles from the \$9 environmental impact fee and the \$7.50 supplemental title fee, revenues from which are deposited to the segregated Environmental Fund. However, the Department assumes that owners of these vehicles are not now paying these fees, therefore, there will be no change in revenue to the Environmental Fund as a result of this bill.

The bill also specifically exempts neighborhood electric vehicles from the motor vehicle inspection and maintenance (I/M) program. However, because these vehicles are not subject to the I/M program under current law, the Department anticipates no state fiscal effect resulting from this aspect of the bill.

Local Government Fiscal Estimate: Because the bill eliminates municipal licensing of neighborhood electric vehicles, the Department anticipates that revenues to municipalities resulting from that licensing will decline -- as will the workload associated with that licensing. Because the Department has no information on the number of neighborhood electric vehicles or the fees or workload associated with municipal licensing, the local government fiscal impact is listed as "indeterminate."
