### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

If enacted, this bill would require the Department of Administration to receive bids for work to be performed at a project, other than a highway project, at the site of the project or at a publicly owned or leased facility that is located within 20 miles of that site. Existing staff are not available to meet the increased workload that would be required to hold the bid opening at the project site.

The Department of Administration, Division of State Facilities, regularly conducts bid openings at 2:00 p.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays at the DOA Office Building in Madison. If workload deems it necessary, an opening will be held at 2:00 p.m. on a Friday. There are usually three bids open per day.

To comply with the requirements of this bill, DOA would need to create three additional bid teams consisting of a bid officer and a recorder/witness (six total positions). The teams would be assigned to three regions of the state to reduce travel time and expense.

With the assumption that the bid officers would be paid \$20 per hour and the recorder/witnesses \$15 per hour (plus 39.99% fringe benefit rate), the annual salary and fringe benefits for these employees would be \$305,700. Standard supplies cost for these employees would be \$62,300 plus the cost of a fleet car for each team (\$15,000), room rental for the bid opening (\$12,000), and potential overnight lodging and meals associated with the travel to the project sites (\$1,000). The total annual cost is estimated at \$396,000.

#### Long-Range Fiscal Implications

At a minimum, there would be an annual cost of \$396,000. As salary and fringe benefit costs rise, there would be additional costs for meeting the requirements of the bill.
