Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Bill Summary:

The bill extends the sunset date of July 1, 2007 to July 1, 2010 for the current 55 mile per hour speed limit restriction for snowmobiles, during the hours of darkness.

Fiscal Estimate:

The speed restriction for snowmobiles is currently enforced in Wisconsin by both DNR and local law enforcement safety patrols. Enforcement of this law will continue to be conducted at state and local levels utilizing existing funding. Minor additional state costs involving educating the public through public service announcements can be absorbed within the agency's budget.
