Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2007 AB 526 and companion bill SB 277 limit a snowmobile operator to a speed of 55 miles per hour during the hours of darkness. The prior Act 209 of 2005 had a sunset provision that took effect on July 1, 2007. This legislation would extend the sunset to July 1, 2010.

The State Patrol has ticketed only 2 snowmobile operators during the past two years for a violation of any paragraph under s. 350.10(1), Wis. Stat. Neither of the tickets were for speed.

Therefore, there would be no fiscal impact expected with the longer sunset provision in place.
