Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SB 317 eliminates the Petroleum Storage Environmental Cleanup Council. The council has not convened in over seven years. Code committees that are used on a continuing basis have replaced the council's role and maintained the involvement of stakeholders originally designated for membership.

This process is expected to continue. Therefore, the elimination of the PECFA council is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Department.
