Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Bill Summary: The bill eliminates the Petroleum Storage Environmental Cleanup Council, an advisory council for the petroleum storage remedial action program, commonly known as PECFA, for the Department and for the Department of Commerce. The bill also removes the reference in statutes relating to the Department of Commerce's need to consult with the Council to determine proof of financial responsibility of PECFA sites. Commerce currently determines proof of financial responsibility of PECFA sites and this bill will simply remove the need to consult with the Council.

Fiscal Estimate: The Department assumes that, because the Council has not met for several years (last in 1996) and has been replaced by advisory committee efforts, this bill will have no state fiscal impact.
