Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would require the Department to establish a program for collecting manometers in use on dairy farms. The bill also authorizes a manufacturer or user of certain mercury–added products to petition for, and the secretary of DATCP to grant, an exemption from the bill's prohibitions.

The annual cost for this program is indeterminate. There are over 12,000 dairy farms in Wisconsin and no information on the number of farms using manometers. It is not known how many manufacturers may petition for an exemption on the use of certain mercury added products. If a manufacturer were to petition for an exemption, it is unknown how easily the petitioner could establish certain facts required to earn an exemption.

We anticipate that it would take approximately 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 2 years to promulagate the rule for this program. These costs would be absorbed.
