### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

#### PROVISIONS OF THE BILL

Under current law, with few statutorily enumerated exceptions, an oversize or overweight permit may only be issued for a load that cannot reasonably be divided into more than one load so as to not exceed size or weight limits. This applies both to single trip permits and to annual or consecutive monthly permits, which allow multiple trips during a specified time period.

This bill adds to the exceptions to the "non-divisible" requirement, a single trip permit for oversize mobile home, manufactured home, or modular home sections. The bill allows a single trip permit to be issued for a load that includes more than one home section if each home section is a component of the same home, and the overall load is within the size limits specified in the permit.

The bill does not affect annual or consecutive monthly permits for transport of mobile homes, under s.348.27 (7).

#### FISCAL IMPACT

No fiscal impact on DOT or the Transportation Fund.

Single trip permits for modular homes, mobile homes, and manufactured homes are issued by the Department of Transportation, not by local governments. No fiscal impact on local governments.
