



WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2007 Wisconsin Act 138
[2007 Assembly Bill 595]

**Remedial Legislation [Department
of Transportation]**

This legislation was suggested as remedial legislation by the Department of Transportation (DOT) and introduced by the Joint Legislative Council's Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4. and 5., Stats.

2007 Wisconsin Act 138 corrects an apparent oversight by requiring that a title applicant inform DOT whether the vehicle was hail damaged (and not repaired by a replacement part) in order to permit DOT to record on the title that the vehicle was a hail-damaged vehicle.
