## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

<b>2007 Assembly Bill 685</b>	<b>Assembly Amendment 1</b>

*Assembly Bill 685*, among other items, requires the clerk of court to provide, without charge, a copy of the statute relating to parenting plans to each person filing a petition to commence an action affecting the family (e.g., divorce) if the petition shows that the parties have a minor child. In addition, a copy of the statute must be included in the summons for such an action.

*Assembly Amendment 1* requires the provision of the parenting plan statute *or* a parenting plan form if a standard form for parenting plans is used in the county.

### **Legislative History**

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by Representative Albers. On March 5, 2008, the Assembly Committee on Children and Family Law recommended adoption of the amendment on a vote of Ayes, 7; Noes, 0; and recommended passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 7; Noes, 0.
