Assembly Bill 725 provides an annual exemption for certain sales that occur during a one-week period including Earth Day of personal property that satisfies the energy efficiency guidelines of the federal Energy Star program.

Assembly Amendment 2 narrows the property that qualifies for the exemption to the following dishwashers, clothes washers, air conditioners, ceiling fans, incandescent or fluorescent light bulbs, humidifiers, programmable thermostats, freezers, and refrigerators. The amendment also provides that the exemption does not apply to otherwise qualified property that is leased.

Legislative History

Assembly Amendment 2 was offered by Representative Strachota. On February 20, 2008, the Assembly Committee on Ways and Means adopted the amendment by a vote of Ayes, 13; Noes, 0; and recommended the bill for passage, as amended, by a vote of Ayes, 13; Noes, 0.
