*Special Session Senate Bill 1* provides in part that no person may make a contribution to an incumbent partisan state elective official or a candidate for a partisan state office during the period beginning on the date of introduction of the Executive Budget Bill and ending on the date of enactment of the Biennial Budget Act.

*Senate Amendment 1* provides that the period during which a contribution may not be made will begin on January 1 of each odd-numbered year.

**Legislative History**

On February 28, 2008, the Senate Committee on Campaign Finance Reform, Rural Issues and Information Technology introduced and adopted Senate Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 4; Noes, 0. On the same date, the committee recommended passage of Special Session Senate Bill 1, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 3; Noes, 1.
