**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2009 SENATE BILL 263**

March 4, 2010 – Offered by Representatives RADCLIFFE, ZIEGELBAUER, VAN ROY,
TURNER, VAN AKKEREN, VRUWINK and HRAYCHUCK.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 5: delete that line and substitute “Public Defender, assistant
district attorneys, requiring the exercise of rule-making authority, and making an
appropriation.”.

3 **2.** Page 5, line 10: after that line insert:

4 “(2) FURLOUGHS PROHIBITED FOR ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS. Notwithstanding
5 Executive Order 285, no assistant district attorney may be required to take more
6 than 5 days of unpaid leave during each fiscal year of the 2009–11 fiscal biennium.

7 (3) LAYOFFS PROHIBITED FOR ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS. Notwithstanding
8 sections 111.84 (1) and (2), 111.91 (1) and (2), 111.93 (3), and 230.34 (2) of the statutes
9 and any collective bargaining agreement affecting assistant district attorneys, no
10 assistant district attorney may be laid off during the 2009–11 fiscal biennium.
