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

6 enter into any compact that has been negotiated under 25 USC 2710 (d).

7 **SECTION 1i.** 14.035 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

8 14.035 (2) In negotiating a compact, or the renewal, extension, or amendment
9 of a compact, under sub. (1) with an American Indian tribe or band, the governor
10 shall request that the tribe or band adopt prohibitions against smoking in all
11 facilities located in this state in which gaming is conducted, and in all taverns and

1 restaurants associated with the facilities, that are consistent with the prohibitions
2 against smoking under s. 101.123.”.

3 **2.** Page 3, line 1: delete “**SECTION 1**” and substitute “**SECTION 1m**”.

Subject: casino amendment to smoking bill

Rep. Hubler,

I drafted an amendment to the smoking bill for you that requires the governor to request when negotiating Indian gaming compacts that the Indian tribes and bands adopt prohibitions against smoking that are applicable to facilities in which "gaming" is conducted, and in associated restaurants and taverns (LRBa0330/1). I didn't define "gaming". The federal law on Indian gaming refers to three classes of gaming. Class I covers games that are irrelevant to the amendment ("social games for prizes of minimal value). Class II covers bingo. Class III covers everything else.

Do you want to cover bingo halls such as DeJope and any other place on Indian lands where bingo is played? Or, do you just want to cover the places that have Class III gaming, the places that are commonly referred to as casinos? Please let me know if you would like me to redraft the amendment to be more precise?

As it turns out, I need to make a correction to LRBa0330 regardless of whether you redraft it to define "gaming". On p. 1, lines 3 and 5, the renumbering should be to 14.035 (1), not (2).

I can make this correction either by redrafting or by asking for a chief clerk's correction. If you send back the jacket for the amendment, I will make the technical correction and hold onto the amendment pending any further instruction on whether you want to redraft to define "gaming."
