Amendments for Global Warming Bill AB 649/SB 450

Based on April 15, 2010 Leg Council Memo to Rep. Huebsch

Delete provision expanding the Energy Efficiency program to include unregulated fuels - LP Gas and Heating Oil
Maintain Current Law with respect to Focus on Energy (Delete 2% Electricity Consumption Standard and 0.2% ARTS)
Return RPS to current law and federalize (re-draft Huebsch amendment LRB 2220/1)
Delete provision that creates legislative findings to lay out basis for in-state portion of RPS (re-draft Huebsch amendment LRB 2216/1)
End the Nuclear Power Moratorium (re-draft Huebsch Amendment LRB 2222/1)
Return all nuclear power plant provisions back to current law
Delete provision on local gov planning grants that requires DOA to give preference to applications that have comprehensive plans
Delete provision that creates DOA-administered grant program for local government planning
Delete provision on Growth Accomodation Incentives
Delete provision requiring Commerce to create energy codes for commercial, one and two-family dwellings
Delete provision expanding the municipal energy efficiency improvement loan program
Delete provision requiring DNR to prescribe forest stewardship management plan practices
Delete provision permitting DNR to lessen permitting obligations projects reducing GHG
Delete provision declaring statewide goals for state GHG reductions
Delete provision creating Climate Change Council and requirement for quadrennial reports to the Legislature
Delete provision directing DOT and DNR to estimate GHG generated by transportation
