Eric,
the intent of this is that demolition and construction materials are recycled either by transferring to a third party- i. e. the private sector or by government in the case that the county or municipality has a C&D reuse and recycling program. How LRB cobbled this language to be so convoluted... and they left out reuse which we explicitly told them multiple time. The intent was NOT to have C&D materials go to a government entity. We should call LRB to make sure that their language does in fact reflect the intent.

Subject: Recycling Standard in AB 843 and SB 616

Eric and Ryan, I'd greatly appreciate your help interpreting the recycling requirement in SB 616 and AB 843 (page 6, line 22). It reads:

c. That at least 75 percent of the construction materials delivered to the project site but not used in the project and the demolition materials from any demolition required to undertake the project are recycled in the project or transferred to a 3rd party for recycling as a part of another construction project for an agency, as defined in s. 16.70 (1e), or a local governmental unit, as defined in s. 19.42 (7u).

Does this exclude recycling by transferring materials to a recycling company that directs the materials to new users that are not government entities? Most construction and demolition recycling does involve directing unwanted materials to recycling companies that process the materials for eventual transfer them to new users.


