

Mitch

Highlights – UW-Stevens Point Basketball 2010

- UWSP is just the third team to win more than two national titles, joining North Park (5) and UW-Platteville (4).
- Senior Matt Moses was named the Final Four's Most Outstanding Player; Jared Jenkins was also named to the All-Tournament Team
- Moses was named to the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) State Farm Division III All-West District First Team
- Coach Bob Semling named 2010 Molten/DIII News Coach of the Year, the second coach from UWSP to receive the award (Jack Bennett '04)
- Coach Bob Semling named 2010 D3hoops.com Coach of the year
- Coach Bob Semling named 2010 National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Division III Coach of the Year
- Matt Moses named to D3hoops.com All-West Region Second Team
- 29 victories this season ties the school record for wins in a season, set by 2004 and 2005 national championship teams
- Pointers won a league-best sixth Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) tournament title, defeating UW-Whitewater in Whitewater, to earn the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.
- The Pointers have never lost in Salem, going a perfect 6-0 at the Salem Civic Center.
- 14 of 15 players on the roster are Wisconsin natives
- Junior captain Louis Hurd was a finalist for the Elite 88 award, given to the student-athlete with the highest cumulative grade-point average participating in the finals
