This should be the last request for today so hopefully I don't mess it up too bad ☺

Andy would like an amendment to create two segregated funds for addressing costs associated with raw milk.

- As we talked about we would like the fee to be 4 dollars a gallon making sure that it covers the 2 dollars for a half or 8 dollars for 2 gallons.
 - 25% (\$1 on a gallon) would go to DATCP to cover the administrative costs of testing, tracking, monitoring, and permitting these dairies.
 - 75% (\$3 on a gallon) would go into a Public Safety Fund to address county costs associated with an outbreak.
