Whereas, on March 25, 1821, the Greek nation began its fight for independence and waged a successful War of Independence (1821-1829) and reinstated a democratic form of government; and

Whereas, it was Greece that first ignited the flame of freedom and is still known as the "cradle of democracy" by, during the sixth and fifth centuries B.C., in Athens, introducing to the world the idea of direct representative government, thus ushering in a golden age of art, architecture, philosophy, and drama under such giants of Western history as Pericles, Sophocles, Euripides, Socrates, and Plato; and
