RESOLUTION NO. 41-2009

SUPPORTING MARINETTE MARINE CORPORATION/FINCANTIERI LITTORAL COMBAT SHIP PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Marinette Common Council supports industry and development efforts that significantly impact local employers and the economic growth of our region, and therefore, supports the marine industry and operations in northeast Wisconsin and the central Upper Peninsula neighbors; and

ACKNOWLEDGING THAT, the Department of Navy has decided to cancel a split-buy approach and award a winner-take-all contract of up to ten Littoral Combat Ships (LCS) utilizing just one design and shipyard in fiscal year 2010; and

WHEREAS, Marinette Marine Corporation/Fincantieri is a competitor in this process and selection of their shipyard could mean as many as 1,500 jobs to the region over the next three years; and

ACKNOWLEDGING THAT, Marinette Marine Corporation/Fincantieri is in the process of building another LCS (LCS-3), the Fort Worth, scheduled for delivery to the U.S. Navy in 2012, after delivering the Marinette-built LCS-1, USS Freedom, to the Navy late last year; and

ACKNOWLEDGING THAT, representatives for Marinette Marine and Lockheed Martin are confident in their design and ability to produce the ships for the Navy on time and on budget.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Marinette Common Council is in support of the project, and encourages complete support by the community, state and federal leaders of this project to bring the construction of the LCS to Marinette Marine for the continued growth of our region.





3 Whereas, the senate supports industry and development efforts that have a
4 significant impact on employers and the economic growth of the state and our region
5 and, therefore, supports the marine industry and operations in northeast Wisconsin
6 and Michigan's central upper peninsula; and

7 Whereas, the Department of the Navy has decided to cancel a split-buy
8 approach and award a winner-take-all contract of up to ten littoral combat ships
9 (LCS) using just one design and shipyard in fiscal year 2010; and

10 Whereas, Marinette Marine Corporation is a competitor in this process and
11 selection of its shipyard could mean that as many as 1,500 new jobs will come to the
12 region in the next three years; and

13 Whereas, the Marinette Marine Corporation is currently building another
14 LCS, the USS Fort Worth (LCS-3), scheduled for delivery to the U.S. Navy in 2012,

1 and it has just completed building the USS Freedom (LCS-1) which was delivered
2 to the Navy late last year; and

3 Whereas, representatives for Marinette Marine Corporation and Lockheed Martin are
4 confident in their design and ability to produce the ships for the Navy on time and
5 on budget; now, therefore, be it

6 **Resolved by the senate, That** the members of the senate support the
7 LCS-building project and encourage complete support of this project by community, Corporation
8 state, and federal leaders to bring construction of the LCS to Marinette Marine for
9 the continued growth of our region.
