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

**PRIMARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION**

This bill creates a new appropriation for the deposit of federal economic stimulus funds, to be received by the state pursuant to federal legislation enacted during the 111th Congress. The economic stimulus funds are to be expended by DPI for the purposes for which received.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

2 SECTION 1. 20.255 (2) (n) of the statutes is created to read:

3 20.255 (2) (n) *Federal aid; economic stimulus funds.* All federal moneys  
4 received, as authorized by the governor under s. 16.54, as economic stimulus funds  
5 pursuant to federal legislation enacted during the 111th Congress to be expended for
