The draft on the GPR statutory ending balance should be set at \$65 million in FY10 through FY13 and 2% thereafter.

The current requirement for a structural balance in each year (annual revenues exceed annual expenditures) needs to be modified to only have that requirement in the second year of the biennium. This requirement also has to be waived for FY09. The FY09 provision needs to be in both the early bill and the budget bill.
