Hi Robin,

Can you please draft an amendment for Representative Townsend regarding the nursing home bed assessment proposal.

The first part of his amendment is identical to the draft you did for [REDACTED]: Only assess occupied nursing home beds with a monthly bed assessment of \$100.70 per bed per month in 2009-10 and an assessment of \$139.20 per month in 2010-11. The appropriation changes would also be the same.

The second part of his request would increase the required DOA lapse amount established as part of 2007 Wisconsin Act 20 by \$26,222,700. I believe this amount is currently reflected in section 3416d of ASA 1 to AB 75.
