Allow all IRIS participants to be able to access assistance from the Disability Ombudsman program, just as Family Care and Partnership enrollees can get assistance.

**Agency:** Department of Health Services

**Summary:** *Provide a thorough description. Please attach all supporting documentation and talking points.*

The IRIS program is a new, small program which allows people to use the self determination model to direct their own long-term care services. It is a non-managed care alternative to Family Care available only in the Family Care counties. Right now the enrollment is in the 200-300 range statewide. Since each person has to be eligible for Family Care to be able to choose IRIS, the enrollment projections for the Family Care program already include the eventual IRIS enrollees.

Consequently there is no fiscal impact of including IRIS participants in the eligibility for the Disability Ombudsman program which both the governor and JFC included in their respective version of the budget (the JFC version is funded at a higher level than the governor's version because JFC agreed to keep the ratio of Ombudsmen to Enrollees at 1.0 : 2,500, rather than the 1.0: 3500 that DHS proposed to reduce it to).
