Assembly Democratic Caucus Amendment

Allow the Department of Workforce Development to assess liquidated damages of \$50-500 per violation for failure to provide a pay statement in accordance with 103.457 of the Wisconsin Statutes. (This tool is another way to penalize employers who are paying their workers in cash to avoid tax withholding, overtime, UI, and WC policies. It provides an incentive for employees who are being coerced to accept cash and work long hours without overtime or other benefits to file a complaint with the Department of Workforce Development.)
