Robin and Tami,

We received several amendment requests to the JFC sub from the Senate Democratic Caucus. The following list provides the requests that relate to Public Health (my comments are in italics)

I'm providing the requests as we received them--some are pretty vague. Let me know what needs to be clarified, and I'll get back in touch with the caucus contact. Also, I have hard copies of all these requests, if you need to see them.

- JJD
1. Provide \$100,000 of Ryan White Part B grant funds to the Black Health Coalition of Milwaukee [*Black Health Coalition of Wisconsin?*].

2007 Act 20 had a provision that implemented this same amendment (Section 9121 (9p)). I think the only changes would need to be to the appropriation reference (s. 20.435(1)(a) instead of s. 20.435(5)(a)), and changing the state fiscal year reference to 2009-10.

2. Exempt swimming pools under 2,500 square feet at a private club in Milwaukee from the requirement under DHS administrative rule 172.23 regarding lifeguard supervision if the facility has a policy that prohibits use of the pool by minors unless accompanied by an adult.

Apparently, this is supposed to target the Milwaukee Athletic Club. I'm not sure the best way to draft this--the above language is how I received the request.

3. Provide \$600,000 GPR in 2009-10 to Milwaukee Health Services, Inc., to add 10-14 dental chairs at a clinic on the Northwest side [*of Milwaukee*] that would be staffed by 3-4 dentists and 1 hygienist.

5 health services shall provide to the Black Health Coalition of Wisconsin, Inc.,
6 \$100,000 in the first fiscal year of the fiscal biennium in which this subsection takes
7 effect as a grant to provide human immunodeficiency virus infection outreach,
8 education, referral, and other services."
