Senator Fitzgerald's office advised to send budget amendment drafting requests to you and that you will coordinate. Below are the Senator's drafting requests:

- Remove the provision for Nonresident Tuition Exemptions for Certain Undocumented Persons at UW System Schools

- Remove the Driver Card for Applicants Without Proof of Legal Presence provision
- Remove the Motor Vehicle Insurance Provisions
- Remove the creation of the KRM Authority
- Remove the creation of the Milwaukee County Regional Transit Authority
- Remove the creation of the Dane County Regional Transit Authority
- Remove the creation of the Fox Valley Regional Transit Authority
- Remove the Creation of the Chippewa Valley Regional Transit Authority
- Local vote to approve each RTA, 5 amendments, one for each RTA

Employee Trust Funds

- Remove the Domestic Partnership provisions
- Remove mandate that dependents of state and local employees can stay on employees insurance until the age of 27
- Remove Retirement eligibility for Educational Support Personnel
- Draft motion to that funds deducted by ETF and remitted to an employee organization may not be directly or indirectly contributed to a political action committee of any kind

Office Of Insurance

- Remove the mandatory insurance coverage of contraception
- Remove the mandate on pharmacists to fill all prescriptions
- Remove the mandate that provides mental health parity
- Remove the mandate that requires autism coverage
- Remove all changes to several liability including the jury instructions

Children and Families

- Remove the Day Care Rating program mandate and funding under Children and Families
- Remove collective bargaining provisions for Day Care Providers
- Reinstate the grace period for day care van alarms
- remove earmark for funding of two child advocacy centers in Green County and Wood county
- Reinstate the provision that fathers who are behind on child support are not eligible for food stamps

Department of Instruction

- Go back to current law on the Qualified Economic Offer
- Remove the increases to the Revenue Limits under General School Aids
- Remove the requirement that Choice schools administer the 4th, 8th, and 10th grade knowledge and concepts examination
- Remove the staff credential requirements for choice schools
- Remove the teacher's aides requirements for choice schools
- Remove all School Choice program school accreditations modifications
- Remove the requirement that School Choice schools have to a bilingual-bicultural education program if enrollment is more that 10% limited English proficient
- Remove all School Choice schools provisions of information added by gov and JFC
- Remove choice program required meeting provision
- Remove the creation of a second option for the transfer of progress records for a choice school that ceases operations
- Remove pupil priority under enrollment limit modifications made in the bill
- remove the mandate on schools to transport pregnant teens to school if they live less than two miles from the school
- Delete the changes to the Parent contracts for pupil transportation modifications

Department of Health

- remove the increase the nursing home bed tax
- Remove collective bargaining provisions for Home Healthcare workers
- remove provision that makes ambulance service providers, emergency medical technicians, and first responders included in the definition of health care providers
- remove the provision that states how much a health care provider can charge for paper copies, microfiche copes, and copies of x rays
- Reinstate the provision that allows people to be on W-2 for only 24 months
- remove direction for DHS to conduct study of health insurance coverage family child care providers
- remove the increase in the hospital assessment and expanded to surgical centers.
- Remove Birth Certificate fee increase

DATCP

- Remove all transfer of funds from the Agrichemical fund
- Draft motion that would not allow DATCP to institute a slaughter fee/tax without consent of the full legislature

DOT

- Remove all transfer of funds from Transportation fund
- remove provision allowing people to get license back after 9 months when suspended instead of the current 2 years
- Reinstate 12/31/09 sunset of \$9 vehicle environmental impact fee

OJA

- Delete Racial Profiling provision for all law enforcement agencies

DNR

- Remove all provisions that deny public access to ALL Stewardship land
- Remove increase in boat registration fees
- Remove tipping fee increase

UW-System

- Remove collective bargaining provisions for UW Faculty and Staff
- Remove collective bargaining provisions for UW Research Assistants

General Fund

- Remove the expansion of the Premier resort area tax
- reinstate the Domestic Production Activities deduction
- Remove the decrease in the capital gains exclusion
- remove modifications made to the streamline sales tax
- Remove the tobacco tax increase
- Delete the new income tax bracket created in the budget

DWD

- Remove all prevailing wage changes

PSC

- remove all earmarks for the 911 fund balance and go back to current law with rebates being given to users
- remove the 75 cent increase on everyone cell phone bill will be identified as supporting police and fire when it really go to the General Fund
- Delete any increase to the Utility public benefits fund

Courts

- Remove the expungement of records under Circuit Courts budget provisions

Lt. Governor's office

- remove the funding for additional position in Lt. Governor's Office

Department of Administration

- Remove the provision to allow the city of Kaukauna to annex in the town of Kaukauna

Corrections

- remove the sentencing modifications for Class C through I Felonies
- remove provision that allows DOC to release an inmate from extended supervision if he/she has served at least 67% of the term of confinement for non violent Class F to I felonies
- remove provision to allow DOC to petition a sentencing court to discharge a person from probation who has served less than 50% of their probation for most misdemeanor offenses

DOJ

- remove increased fee charged to nonprofit organizations for a name search of criminal history database (currently \$2 budget increases to \$7)
- remove provision requiring DOJ to provide one million dollars to split between asst public defenders and asst DA's
- Delete the provision to increase handgun purchaser record check fee

Miscellaneous

- remove the Columbus park decision legislation
- remove emergency medical services fee increase

Earmarks

- remove \$10,000 for Love incorporated Food bank in Burlington
- remove \$5,000 for Union Grove Food Bank
- remove \$5,000 for Rio area food pantry
- remove 45,000 for Lodi food Pantry
- remove \$50,000 for fish and wildlife SEG for Eau Claire County Public Shooting Range
- remove \$25,000 for programming at root river environmental educations Community Center
- remove \$50,000 for Beloit Children's' Playground
- remove \$10,000 for restoration and renovation of Beckman Mill Park in Rock county
- Remove all transfer of funds from the Vital Records Fee Fund
- Remove provision under OJA to provide a home land security grant of \$10,000 to the town of Oakland in Jefferson county for an emergency generator
- Remove all tourism earmarks, return the money to the agency
- Remove the funding under the building commission for the Bradley Center Sports and Entertainment Corporation
