Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill allows a municipality to adopt an ordinance to reserve specific disabled parking spaces for disabled person whose residences is on that same street. It also allows a municipality to charge a fee for issuing a permit and to prohibit other vehicles from parking in disabled designated spaces. A municipality must erect and maintain official traffic signs indicating any parking prohibition or restriction imposed by the ordinance.

1. A number of municipalities could enact an ordinance authorized by this bill but the actual number is indeterminate.
2. The implementation of a disabled residential parking permit program under this legislation may result in regulatory signing being employed along an affected local roadway. Sign costs could be as much as \$50,000 per location.
3. There would also be enforcement, operation and maintenance, and permit program administration costs.
4. It is assumed all costs could be offset by citation and permit program revenue.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

It is assumed long-range costs could be offset by citation and permit program revenue.
