



WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2009 Wisconsin Act 148
[2009 Assembly Bill 57]

Breast-Feeding

Act 148 provides that a mother may breast-feed her child in any public or private location where the mother and child are otherwise authorized to be. In such a location, no person may prohibit a mother from breast-feeding her child, direct a mother to move to another location to breast-feed her child, direct a mother to cover her child or breast while breast-feeding, or otherwise restrict a mother from breast-feeding her child.

Effective date: The Act takes effect on March 25, 2010.
