**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 48,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,
TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 7**

May 11, 2011 – Offered by Representative YOUNG.

- 1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
- 2 **1.** Page 2, line 18: after “activities;” insert “compensation of election officials;”.
- 3 **2.** Page 58, line 3: after that line insert:
- 4 **“SECTION 92m.** 7.03 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 5 7.03 (1) (a) Except as authorized under this paragraph, a reasonable daily
- 6 compensation of not less than \$10 per hour shall be paid to each inspector, voting
- 7 machine custodian, automatic tabulating equipment technician, member of a board
- 8 of canvassers, messenger, and tabulator who is employed and performing duties
- 9 under chs. 5 to 12. ~~Daily compensation~~ Compensation of not less than \$10 per hour
- 10 shall also be provided to inspectors and inspector trainees for attendance at training
- 11 programs conducted by the board and municipal clerks under ss. 7.31 and 7.315.
- 12 ~~Alternatively, such election officials and trainees may be paid by the hour at a~~

1 ~~proportionate rate for each hour actually worked.~~ Any election official or trainee may
2 choose to volunteer his or her services by filing with the municipal clerk of the
3 municipality in which he or she serves a written declination to accept compensation.
4 The volunteer status of the election official or trainee remains effective until the
5 official or trainee files a written revocation with the municipal clerk.”.
