Relating to: various duties of the Department of Revenue, including issuing declaratory judgments, conducting audits and assessments, asserting liability, allowing claims for refunds, awarding the costs of litigation, prohibiting browsing of returns and claims, imposing penalties related to a taxpayer's negligence, requiring the exercise of rule-making authority, and providing a penalty. (FE) By Committee on Senate Organization, by request of Governor Scott Walker, Senator Zipperer, and Representative Strachota. (Report adoption of Senate Amendment 1, Ayes 15, Noes 0, passage as amended recommended by joint committee on Finance, Ayes 12, Noes 3)
