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

Here's what we think would solve the problem (if there still is one):

Issue: Eligible Schools

Location: Page 2, Lines 18-20

Language: (a) "Eligible school" means a public school located in this state but outside the pupil's school district of residence, including a charter school under s. 118.40 (2r) or 118.40 (8) located in this state, or a private school located in this state.

Rationale: The current language could be interpreted to mean that only independent charter schools outside the student's school district are eligible. Also, since there are two different types of independent charter schools, the authors wanted to ensure that both types are explicitly considered eligible.

All these amendments look great. One change and then kind of an interesting question...

There is still a concern on the Charter school language on page 2 lines 18-20. The way some read it is that the only eligible charter schools would be those outside the resident school district. Does the change we made on page 3 cover this, or should we clarify more?

Additionally, we would like all the amendments you have drafted combined into one amendment. I think these are all the LRB #s (please let me know if I'm missing one):

A2658/1, a2621/1, a2619/1, a2620/1, a2664/1.

Now the interesting question: Could we get two different versions of this one big amendment drafted. One with the current language you have relating to the child being ineligible if its determine he/she no longer has the disability, and one with just the IEP will be re-evaluated but says nothing about eligibility.
