

- 2 (d) of the statutes; **relating to:** membership on the State Trails Council.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Under current law, the State Trails Council (council) advises the Department of Natural Resources regarding the planning, acquisition, development, and management of state trails. The council consists of nine members, appointed by the governor for four-year terms, who are knowledgeable in various recreational uses of trails.

This bill expands the membership of the council from nine to eleven members. The bill also requires that the council include ~~one~~ member who represents snowmobile users, ~~one~~ member who represents all-terrain vehicle users, ~~one~~ member who represents users of motor vehicles that have four wheels and that are manufactured principally for off-highway use, and ~~one~~ member who represents users of off-highway motorcycles that are manufactured principally for off-highway use.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

- 3 SECTION 1. 15.347 (16) of the statutes is renumbered 15.347 (16) (intro.) and
- 4 amended to read:

ASSEMBLY BILL 600

SECTION 1

1 15.347 (16) STATE TRAILS COUNCIL. (intro.) There is created in the department  
 2 of natural resources a state trails council consisting of 9 (11) members, appointed for  
 3 4-year terms, who are knowledgeable in the various recreational uses of trails. The  
 4 membership of the council shall include all of the following: <sup>consist</sup>

5 SECTION 2. 15.347 (16) (a) to (d) of the statutes are created to read:

6 15.347 (16) (a) One member who represents all-terrain vehicle users.

7 (b) One member who represents snowmobile users.

8 (c) One member who represents users of motor vehicles with 4 wheels that are  
 9 manufactured principally for off-highway use.

10 (d) One member who represents users of motorcycles that are manufactured  
 11 principally for off-highway use.

12 SECTION 3. Nonstatutory provisions.

13 (1) INITIAL TERMS. Notwithstanding the length of terms specified for the  
 14 <sup>voting</sup> members of the state trails council under section 15.347 (16) <sup>(b)</sup> of the statutes, as  
 15 <sup>created</sup> affected by this act, the terms of the <sup>2</sup> initial <sup>voting</sup> members of the expanded membership  
 16 shall expire on July 1, 2011 <sup>2015</sup>

17 (2) APPOINTMENTS UPON EXPIRATION OF TERMS. Notwithstanding the  
 18 requirements for membership on the state trails council under section 15.347 (16) of  
 19 the statutes, as affected by this act, any member who is serving on the state trails  
 20 council on the day before the effective date of this subsection may continue to serve  
 21 as a member of the council under section 15.347 (16) of the statutes, as affected by  
 22 this act, for the term for which the member was appointed or until his or her  
 23 successor is appointed and qualified, whichever occurs later. Beginning on the  
 24 effective date of this subsection, as vacancies occur on the council, the governor shall

X This bill expands the membership of the council from nine to fifteen members, and requires four of the members to be nonvoting members. The bill requires the secretaries, or their designees, of the Department of Transportation, the Department of Tourism, and the Department of Natural Resources to serve as nonvoting members of the council. The bill requires the fourth nonvoting member to be a person with expertise with regard to accessibility challenges for individuals with physical disabilities.

X The bill also requires that the eleven voting members of the council each represent a specific interest group. Those groups include snowmobile operators, all-terrain vehicle operators, off-road motorcycle operators, equestrians, cross-country skiers, and hikers.

- 6           6. One member who represents recreational hikers and walkers.
- 7           7. One member who represents on-road bicyclists.
- 8           8. One member who represents mountain or off-road bicyclists.
- 9           9. One member who represents cross country skiers.
- 10          10. One member who represents skateboarders and rollerbladers.
- 11          11. One member who represents persons who engage in activities on water
- 12          trails.
