I left you a message regarding AB 239 (LRB 0405) and what the penalty would be for failure to provide notification as a sex offender would be required to do under this bill.

Additionally, Rep. Kleefisch would like to draft an amendment to this bill that would exempt juvenile sex offenders who are students at the school from having to abide by this requirement given that 1) they're students; and 2) their supervisor can work with school officials to ensure the safety of the students attending the school with the juvenile sex offender.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 12: after that line insert:

3 “(d) A juvenile, as defined in s. 938.02 (10m), who is enrolled at the school if the
4 department, county department, licensed child welfare agency, or other person
5 supervising the juvenile under a dispositional order under s. 938.34 works with the
6 school district clerk, if the premises are affiliated with a public school, or with the
7 governing body of the school, if the premises are affiliated with a private school or
8 charter school, to ensure the safety of the students attending the school with the
9 juvenile.”.
